European Veterans Individual Fencing Championships Thionville, France 17th-21st May 2023

The European Individual Championships are open entry, with no limit on numbers, so it is an ideal opportunity to fence at a major international event. If you have not been to a European Championships before, it is a thoroughly recommended experience, even if you are relatively new to fencing. All weapons are fenced in age groups:

Cat 1 40-49, Cat 2 50-59, Cat 3 60-69, Cat 4 70+. Age is at 31/12/2023.

Format:

Pools of 6 or 7 fencers, bouts of 5 hits of 3 minutes. After the pools, direct elimination to 10 hits, 2 rounds of 3 minutes, with one minute pause between each round. Sabre: 1 minute pause after 5 hits. If there are fewer than 10 fencers in a category: Single pool. No elimination after the pools.

Weapon control will be the day before each weapon, so make sure your travel arrangements allow for you to be there at least one day before you are fencing. Opening times have not been published yet but there will be evening sessions.

Eligibility

Equipment

- All equipment must be in good condition and working order, complying with FIE regulations
- It is mandatory that your surname and GBR is printed on the back of your lamé (foil and sabre) or jacket (epee) The print must be dark blue and the size of the letters between 8 and 10 cm high. All prints must be legible.
- It is recommended, but not mandatory, that you have national colours on your breeches and foil/epee jacket.
- All the logos and marks of the manufacturer logos must be in conformity with FIE requirements.

Thionville

Thionville is situated in North West France on the left bank of the River Moselle, in the heart of the `Land of the Three Borders', a region grouping France, Germany and Luxembourg. You can find more information and tourist options on the event website.

Driving

The distance from Calais to Thionville, avoiding toll charges by driving mostly through Belgium, is 276 miles with a driving time of approximately 4.5 hours (without stops).

Driving through France via A46 would incur toll costs of approximately 40 Euros each way.

Accommodation

Hotels are filling fast and there is limited accommodation in Thionville, so if you have not already booked, don't delay. There will not be an official GBR hotel as there will be too many of us.

Entries

Entries must be made through BVF. Entry forms and further information will be sent out soon, with details of payment.

The cost of weapon entry, set by EVF, is as follows:

1 weapon – 85 Euros 2 weapons – 120 Euros 3 weapons – 155 Euros

This includes a fee towards the cost of referees.

The BVF Treasurer, Paul, has been keeping a close eye on Euro exchange rate and will provide the \pounds cost to be paid to BVF. There will be a \pounds 25 management levy, which will be used for TM costs and any BVF admin costs incurred with this event. There will not be a charge for accompanying persons by BVF nor by the organisers for accreditation. Whilst BVF does not seek to make a profit, any surplus will go towards costs for the World Championships (TM/team entry fees/BVF admin).

Entries will be open for registration from 14th February – 11th April. Late entries will <u>not</u> be accepted by the organisers. If you need to cancel your registration you must let me know before 1st May so that I can notify the organisers. 1st May is the cut-off date for refunds of entry fee. No refunds will be made by the organisers for cancellations notified after this date.

Once entries are open and the process starts, you will be able to see who has entered (link to follow).

Tracksuits

The BVF committee is currently looking to replace the existing tracksuit, to be available for Thionville, but it will not be compulsory to purchase a new one. Details to follow.
