Archie Corble (1883-1944)

Archie Corble became British sabre champion for the second time in 1927 at the age of 44. He had learned to fence as a 19-year-old member of the Artillery Volunteer Force and went on to win the sabre competition at the Royal Military Tournament in 1908. He represented Britain at three Olympics: 1912, 1924 and 1928.

During the First World War Corble was stationed in Luxor, upper Egypt, where he challenged and beat a local champion at single-stick. He returned to England in 1920 and 2 years later became British sabre champion for the first time.

Throughout his career as a chartered surveyor and during his spare time at fencing events, Corble collected the history of fencing. By the Second World War he had amassed the greatest collection of books on fencing and duelling ever assembled – over 2000 volumes. When the great library of the University of Leuven in Belgium was destroyed in both world wars, he felt a strong desire to help and on his death in 1944 he left the university his entire collection of fencing books, where they remain to this day.

Archie Corble's dashing style can be seen in a photograph taken in 1922 at the wedding of former British ladies' champion Millicent Hall, when he staged a mock duel.
