Chairman's letter



Dear Members,

It is hard to believe that another year is drawing to an end. What is it about getting older and time passing quicker.....?

It has been a successful year for BVF with some good events and excellent results both at home and internationally.

The committee has worked hard this year and I am pleased that all members stood for re-election at the AGM in September and were elected. Malcolm Fare and John Mason accepted their co-opted positions as Publicity Officer and IT Consultant and Carl Morris accepted the role of Chairman of Selectors again, reappointing Jane Hutchison, Neal Mallett and Gillian Worman as his team. John Mason continues as Chairman of Ranking System Committee, working on BVF Ranking with Graham Paul, Lindsay Watkiss and Hugh Kernohan. Lucy Wright took on the workload as Membership Secretary earlier this year and she now officially has this portfolio. I am sure that you will agree with me that she is doing a fantastic job, particularly keeping membership up to date and entertained with her regular, brilliant e-letters, and she is now co-posting on the BVF Facebook page too. Lucy, thank you very much. You are a star!

At the AGM there was a very interesting and passionate debate on the proposal to change the name of British Veterans Fencing to British Masters Fencing, with strong views on both sides. The motion was very narrowly defeated, so we remain British Veterans Fencing. The committee withdrew the proposed constitution changes as there was an error in the documentation, which had been overlooked.

The committee has recently spent a lot of time discussing the rules for selection for 2020 for the European Team Championships and World Championships and then agreed on the rules format for both events. Special thanks to Carl, Lucy and John for the work they subsequently put in to fine tune the wording. The rules can be found on the BVF website:

Selection Ranking Points will be accumulated by the best two results from the following three events:

BVF International (4/5 January in Guildford)

BVF Championships (28 February – 1 March in Nottingham)

BVF Age Groups (28/29 March in Manchester)

Graham Paul, IFO, is Event Manager for the BVF International Open, which includes EVF Circuit Epee (see page 8). Entry for this is now closed with 361 weapon entries from 320 fencers, 219 of which are for Epee with 18 European countries represented including GBR!

Lindsay Watkiss, DFO has been working with David Sweeney and Marcia Stretch on the BVF Championships which are being held in Nottingham, 28 February - 1 March, and this promises to be a special event. Mike Swiffin is the Event Manager for the BVF Age Groups and plans for this are well in hand.

I was delighted to be able to go the Hampshire Open to take some photos in September. This was a fabulous weekend with both Senior and Veterans competitions; well run by Jenny Morris and team, a great social with a meal out on the Saturday, good fencing and a friendly atmosphere all round. All that a good Vets event should be! I thoroughly recommend that you consider entering the 2020 'Hamster'!

Marcia Stretch very ably ran the Winton Cup at RAF Cosford with DT: John Crouch, John Mason and Mike Robinson. We were delighted to welcome Carol Winton again, who presented the Winton Cup and medals to winning team, South East. The committee decided to award what were individual trophies to the best teams for each weapon. Results are on page 10. Congratulations to South East and all Team winners!

It was an honour and pleasure for me to be Team Manager for the World Championships in Cairo, Egypt in October. Great Britain had superb results with 4 Gold, 4 Silver and 2 Bronze medals finishing second on the medal table and with a string of last eights as well this was a very successful Championships for us. Our Egyptian hosts made us very welcome and put on a professional, slick and friendly event. Thanks to Egyptian Fencing Federation, Organising Committee and the FIE for such a fantastic Championships. I was honoured to accept an award on behalf of BVF from the Egyptian Fencing Federation for the second highest number of weapon entries, 70. An unexpected but very thoughtful and appreciated gesture. For the first time at a Veterans World Championships, the FIE provided live stream commentary, very able carried out by Karim Bashir, working with Tristan Mueller. An excellent and much appreciated job! Thanks to both. I know that many of you were following at home. (See page 10 for results.) Karim has written a report on the Championships which, together with photos, will be in the January edition of The Sword. Keep a look out!

My thanks to all the committee, Selectors, Ranking System sub-committee, Event Managers, DT, referees and volunteers for their continued hard work and last but certainly not least to you, our BVF membership, for your support.

From the committee, and me personally, I wish you all a Peaceful and Happy Christmas and the best of health, happiness and great fencing in 2020.

1) Apologies for absence

Apologies for absence were received from Silvia Brown and Andrew Brown.

2) Minutes of the AGM held on 23rd March 2018

The minutes were accepted as a true record. Proposed by Jenny Morris and seconded by Janet Baron.

3) Matters Arising

None.



4) Report of Officers

a) Chairman's Report

A copy of the report had previously been circulated via email by Lucy Wright on 1st September 2019 and copies are available on the England Fencing (EF) website. John reminded the meeting that all EVF documents were displayed on the EF website.

b) Secretary's Report

The committee had met and communicated by email and telephone throughout the year. This year the number of members was down by 30 members. As of 31st December 2018 membership stood at 485 (515 in 2017). At that date there were 139 (145) women and 346 (370) men. The age distribution as of 31st December 2018 was:

Thanks go to John Mason for providing the information to help the compilation of this report and sending out emails, to Gillian Aghajan for ensuring England items appear in the BVF newsletter and Lucy Wright for sending information out to members via email.

c) Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's report had been published via email on 1st September 2019. England Fencing subsidised EVF at the Glasgow Home international and each year we receive £1 per member from BVF. The funds stand at £3854.43. The Treasurer's report was accepted. Proposed by Peter Baron and seconded by David Sweeney.

5) Election of Officers and Committee members

The Chairman reported that John Crouch (Chairman), Moya McNamara (Secretary), Caroline Clancy (Treasurer) and Peter Baron and Ev Van Gemeren (Committee members) were willing to stand again and were duly re-elected en bloc. Lucy Wright has resigned and Caryl Oliver was duly elected on to the committee.

6) Any Other Business

a) England Championships: Jane Hutchison had asked that this matter be discussed.

At last year's AGM it was agreed that the committee would carry out a feasibility study by the end of July 2018 into running an England Veterans Fencing Championships (EVFC). If such an event was feasible it would need to be built into the calendar.

This had been looked at and a provisional date in early November at Manchester Fencing Centre had been booked. However on further investigation, given the busy fencing calendar and the fact that no one had come forward to run the event it had been cancelled. It was felt that a central venue was needed and the issue would be looked at again this year.

b) Selection criteria for the England team had not yet been discussed. Once BVF sort out their ranking system we can use that. There are 2 events in 2020 where selection will be needed i.e. the Home International which is likely to be held in the Bristol area and the Commonwealths in Canada.

The meeting closed at 19:40 hours.
