### HENRY RACES AHEAD

Fencing is not enough to keep 75-year-old Henry de Silva active. He also plays competitive table tennis and is a regular race walker. Last month he recorded a time of 35 min 25 sec for a 5 km race walk on the Isle of Man and is now third in the UK national rankings for his age group (75-80).

A keen walker in his youth, Henry won a silver medal in the Surrey county championship at the age of 14 and 5 years later became the county walking club's novice champion. Having recently returned to race walking, he completed a 10-mile walk in 2 hr 03 min 19 sec, which unofficially makes him the fastest man in the country at that distance in his age group. Well done, Henry!

## NOTABLE VETS OF THE PAST

### 4. Edgar Seligman (1867-1958)

Edgar Seligman holds several fencing records: first British epee champion, first man to win the national championship at all three weapons and the only person to achieve that feat twice, oldest fencer to have won a senior championship, and the only British fencer to have won three Olympic silver medals.

By being the highest placed British fencer in the first international epee competition to be held in this country (he came seventh equal), Seligman became the first epee champion of Britain in 1904 and was presented with the bronze shield that ever since has been the British men's epee trophy. He won the epee championship a second time in 1906, when he also became foil champion, retaining his foil title the following year.



At the 1906 Olympics in Athens Seligman was a member of the British epee team that tied with France in the final after, from all accounts, being robbed of the gold medal by dreadful presiding, and subsequently lost the rematch. He collected another silver medal as a member of the epee team at the 1908 Olympics in London, again losing to France, and a third 4 years later in Stockholm, where he was captain, after the team lost to Belgium.

Seligman also captained the foil and epee teams at the 1920 Olympics in Antwerp and was overall team captain at the 1924 Olympics in Paris, where he reached the final poule of eight in the individual foil event, a remarkable achievement at the age of 56. That same year he won the British sabre championship for the second time, having won it first the year before when he was a mere 55; he thus became the first man to win all three national titles.

Edgar Seligman was a vice-president of the AFA and represented Britain at the FIE from its inauguration in 1913 until 1930. He was also a talented artist, as his self-portrait donated to the AFA testifies.

## NATIONAL VETERANS ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIPS 2009

**Venue: Oxstalls Indoor Tennis Centre, Gloucester, GL2 9DW**

**Closing Dates:** Entries must be received by the organisers on or before **Friday 28th February** 2009. Late entries are not accepted. On-line entry available on the NVA web site. Printed entry forms with this newsletter, if you have a printed copy.

**Entry Fees:** £16 for 1 weapon, £28 for 2 weapons and £38 for 3 weapons.

**Eligibility:** The championships are open only to paid up members of the NVA who are eligible to hold a British passport.

**Relevance:** The rankings from the National Championships are used to determine selection for representative events.

**Equipment:** It is the responsibility of each fencer to ensure that personal equipment complies with British Fencing guidelines. The NVA **recommends** FIE standard clothing and masks for personal safety and **requires** maraging blades for the safety of others at Foil and Epée. Sabre blades must comply with current standards of stiffness and be dated 2000 or later. The new rule regarding conductive bibs on the masks at Foil will not apply at this event.

**Over 75's:** Fencers over 75 years of age are only covered for third party injury by their British Fencing membership. Personal injury is not covered. If another fencer injures you any claim that you pursue against that fencer must be at your own expense.

**Leon Paul:** There will be a Leon Paul sales stand at the event.

**Organisation:** The organisers reserve the right to make any changes that they deem necessary to ensure the smooth running of the competition.

**Hotel:** We have negotiated a special accommodation rate at the Holiday Inn, Crest Way, Barnwood, Gloucester, GL4 3RX. (See attached map and travel directions)

The committee have met twice to discuss a selection process for representative teams in 2009 and this was published in the NVA Newsletter.

We look forward to the Commonwealth Veterans Championship which will be held in Jersey on 9-12 July 2009. Anyone can enter the individual events and the England teams will be selected from the best performers on the day.

We are looking at setting a strategy for the future of the Association and any ideas would be most welcome.
